

ADMISSIONS POLICY

NAZEING PRIMARY SCHOOL - ADMISSIONS POLICY

Introduction

This policy reflects the consensus of opinion of the whole teaching staff and has the full agreement of the Governing Body. It is reviewed annually. The implementation of this policy is the responsibility of the management team and administrative staff.

The standard admission number for Nazeing Primary School is 45.

Early Years Admissions

Children born between 1st September and 31st August are admitted full-time in September in line with Government policy.

Admissions Policy

Admission to Nazeing Primary is coordinated by Essex County Council. There is no guarantee of a place for children living in the priority admissions area.

In the event of oversubscription places will be allocated using the following criteria in the order given:

- Looked After children and previously looked after children;
- Children with a sibling attending the school;
- Children living in the priority admissions area;
- Remaining applications.

In the event of oversubscription within any of the above criteria, priority will be determined by straight line distance from home to school, those living closest being given the highest priority.

Review

The Headteacher, staff and Governors will review this policy annually.
