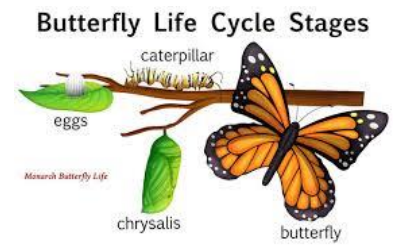




Red and Blue Class Newsletter

Book Care:



Please ensure that they bring their book bags in everyday. Make sure that you use their book bags for their reading book and not their backpacks; as the books become damaged. Water bottles should be carried separately.

Reading:



The children are progressing really well with their reading. It is imperative that you hear your child read at least three times a week. It is important to continue word building with their sounds as well as reading the common words that have been sent home in their envelopes.

Reading regularly helps to develop their confidence, fluency and pace. The books have guidance within the cover to help you extend their learning.

The reading records are a good source of information about how the children are getting on at home with their reading and sound work; please write in them every time you read with your child at home or online.

This term we will be looking at farms, the role of the farmer, farms over time, life cycles of plants and animals. Our role play areas will be a garden centre and a science lab (mini-beasts). If you have any resources that you think would support these areas we would be grateful.

Lastly, please remember to check that their clothes, kits, shoes and coats are still clearly labelled as they wash/rub off in time. On PE days, long hair must be tied back and jewellery is not allowed to be worn, so please ensure that earrings are removed before school on these days.
