Communication and Language:

Use past, present and future tenses to talk about experiences. Encourage questioning of what, who, why and how? Extend their vocabulary exploring the meanings of new and exciting words in drama and role play. Listen to and take account of others views. Listen with enjoyment, and respond to stories, songs, rhymes and poems and make up their own.

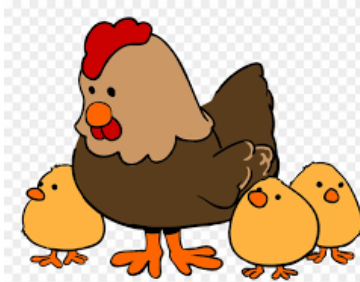
Physical Development: Use the equipment and tools effectively and safely. Show good pencil control and form most letters correctly. Demonstrate strength, balance and coordination. Learn and develop skills in tennis and athletics. Participate in training for football, Develop skipping skills and apply them in country dancing. Perform and co-ordinate their own dance linked to our farm topic.

Personal, Social and Emotional:

Show independence, resilience and perseverance in teacher directed and self-chosen activities. Play co-operatively and show sensitivity to their own and to others' needs. Use My Happy Mind program to understand how to celebrate their bravery and kindness. Manage their own needs. Understand the need for keeping healthy and safe. Prepare for changes.

Literacy: Listen to a range of books including poetry, fiction and non - fiction. Demonstrate an understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories and using new vocabulary. Recognise at least 10 digraphs. Begin to read and understand sentences using phonic knowledge and word recognition. Develop writing by using appropriate sounds, some correct spelling, punctuation and adjectives. Use role play areas to write for different purposes.

All Creatures Great and Small



Role play areas: Science Lab (mini-beasts) and Garden Centre

Mathematics: Count to 20 and recognise the number pattern of numbers to 20. Develop addition and subtraction through practical and formal activities using a number line and subitising skills. Learn number facts to five and some to ten. Know that numbers can be made up from smaller numbers. Learn doubles, odd and even numbers and know that totals can be shared. Investigate shape and position and make their own maps. Make symmetrical patterns.

Expressive Arts and

Design: Learn songs, use glockenspiels and move in different ways to music. Explore a variety of craft techniques within the topics. Explain the process of what they have made. Look at and recreate art work by Eric Carle. Invent and adapt their own stories.

Understanding the World: Look at the features of a farm environment. Find out about the role of the farmer, different farm animals, their young and growing foods. Talk about their experiences of the farm and how farms have changed over time. Explore, watch and record changes of growing plants and caterpillars. Recognise the changes in their environment. Describe features of mini-beasts and understand life-cycles. Find out about different celebrations: Ramadan, Eid and St. George's Day.
